

INSTRUCTIONS

GENERAL INFORMATION:

All absences must be made-up by completing the NSU Marching Band Attendance Assignment. For each absence not made-up with this assignment, the student's grade may be lowered by one grade level. Assignments can be turned in before class or to the Band and Orchestra Office, #180.

ATTENDANCE PACKET CONTENTS:

ABSENCE MAKE-UP REQUIREMENTS:

To resolve your absence the following procedure should be followed to make-up the missed rehearsal/performance.

1. Download this form, appropriate absence form, and music performance sheets (2)
2. Fill out the resolve absence form.
3. View **four (4)** marching band performances in order (volume I - band I-4, 5-8 etc.) from the 2005 Bands of America Finals DVD. The DVD is on reserve under Dr. Vermillion's name or the Marching Band course number MUP 354. You may go to the library or call and request to view the DVD in your dorm room.
4. Complete the judges' sheet for each band. Write comments and scores for each caption on the judge's sheet.

JUDGE'S SHEETS:

Write on the sheet the reviewed band's name and the show concept/music for each. Read the music performance criteria sheet very carefully and try to be as objective as possible on each band's evaluation. All copies of adjudication sheets are the responsibility of the student.

COMPLETING PACKETS

Packets are to be turned into the Graduate Assistant(s) in charge of attendance. Once the packets have been reviewed by Dr. Vermillion and approved, your absence will be marked as resolved in the attendance file.
